Think and remember:

- If it seems too good to be true, be suspicious and take advice.
- Don't be rushed, don't be hushed.
- Never send cash or disclose personal details or buy goods to claim a prize.
- Watch out for secret deals 'get rich quick' schemes and always seek professional advice before signing up to ANY type of investment scheme
- If you receive a suspicious phone call, remember you don't have to get into discussion over the phone with anyone and NEVER talk money.
- Keep your business your business.
- Just say "No thank you, I'm not interested," and hang up straight away.
