



Glossary of star Words and their meaning

Conjunction	Words that connect or link phrases, sentences, clauses or words together.
Expanded noun phrase	Adding more detail to noun using one or more adjectives.
Evaluate	Looking at a piece of work and identifying it's strengths and areas to be improved.
