Dear Parents and Carers,

Our Liverpool Home: Year 2 had a wonderful trip to Liverpool this week. Parents' Meetings: We look forward to welcoming parents and carers of children from Nursery to Year 6 to our teacher and parents' meetings next week. Infant parents should enter school via the infant entrance where there will be an opportunity to view your child(ren)'s books in Year 2. Junior parents should enter through the main entrance, with books being available in the Year 6 classrooms. Mrs James will be located at the main entrance, and Mrs Frazer, our deputy headteacher, will be at the infant entrance.

During the meetings, teachers will explain how your child is settling into their new year group as well as their attitude to work and general behaviour. Teachers will also check that you have updated important information. For example, we need to know immediately if your child has or develops any **medical needs such as allergies or asthma**. Other vital information includes an up-to-date **working phone number for a parent**. **We also need a contact for a relative/close friend who lives outside the family home**. If your child is ill, or in the case of an emergency, we know you would want to be contacted immediately so please ensure that we are always able to do this.
