Dear Parents and Carers,

Christmas-themed excitement started this week with a visit from Father Christmas to our Christmas fayre. The penguin-themed grotto was stunning and the weather gave it an authentic chill. Our children really enjoyed explaining their Christmas wishes to Santa and he was very impressed with how polite Hatton Hill children are. The fayre in the hall was also thoroughly enjoyed with many people commenting on the friendly atmosphere. Such an event takes a great deal of work and I would like to take an opportunity to thank everyone involved. We thank Mr Roscoe (Mrs Roscoe's husband) for lending us the traditional games which are so much fun! Thank you to all the families who supported us; we appreciated all your kind comments. Thank you to my colleagues who gave their time so generously during this busy time of year - some colleagues in particular have spent hours on the event mostly at lunchtime, after school and during weekends.
