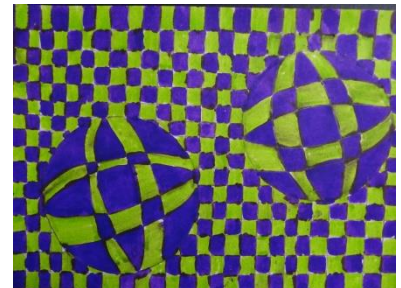
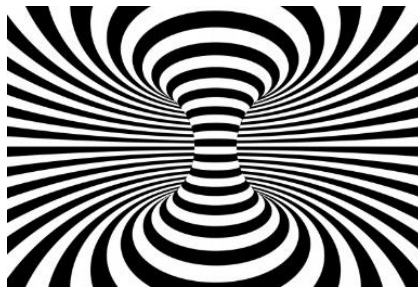


OPTICAL ILLUSIONS
